## MEMBERSHIP PLAN

All members in the National Dropout Prevention Center/Network (NDPC/N) have voting privileges at the annual Business Meeting and are eligible for election to the Board. The Board serves as the major advisory body guiding all NDPC/N policies and program activities.

All members are encouraged to participate in Center/Network activities including: (1) authoring articles for NDPC/N publications, (2) developing resource materials or products jointly with NDPC/N staff, (3) consulting as a team member on NDPC/N demonstration or evaluation projects, or (4) serving on a NDPC/N committee or special interest group. Members are also encouraged to register their interest and expertise in the NDPC/N Professional Consultant Bank (PCB). Registered PCB members become

eligible for providing consultant services to NDPC/N clients requesting unique professional services or technical assistance. Consortium memberships and additional corporate sponsorships will be quoted upon request.
